Ascutney Outdoors has reached another important milestone with the completion of the T-bar. All of our major projects are now behind us!

With all of the pieces in place, we look forward to having both the T-bar and the hugely popular tubing lift in operation this coming season, as well as the rope tow for school groups and the Thursday Night Classic racing program. The Ascutney Outdoor Center has proven to be a perfect gathering place for our four-season recreational activities, the community and school, and outside events.

The mountain has come back! Always integral to West Windsor, it defines the place we call home. Our trails and facilities are here for all of us to enjoy, for a hike or ride, or watching seasons and sunsets. It is a playground for our children and an attraction for visitors. There is a renewed sense of vitality around town and pride in what we have done together.

Everyday activity on the mountain includes hikers and bike riders, skiers and tubers. In addition, in 2019, Ascutney Outdoors hosted 10 major events; 130 Windsor students for a tubing day; 20 rentals of the AOC by community members; an after-school outdoors group; and two new equestrian rides. It was 'standing room only' for the 3rd of July fireworks!

Looking forward, our guiding principal is for Ascutney Outdoors to be financially sustainable. We keep costs low by relying almost entirely on a large group of volunteers.
