Ascutney Outdoors BYOB Policy

Do's & Don'ts

- You may bring up to 1 six-pack of beer or 1 bottle of wine for your personal consumption only per day.
- No cases, kegs, twelve-packs, or other alcohol containers larger than six 12 oz beers or wine coolers are allowed. Cans and plastic bottles are preferred over glass bottles.
- You must be 21 years or older and provide valid photo ID upon request.
- You may not share alcohol with any minor.
- We reserve the right to ask you and your party to leave the premises if you fail to abide by these regulations or become a disturbance to others.

Allowed Areas

- BYOB is allowed in the Ascutney Outdoors Center (AOC) and adjacent deck/patio.
- Alcohol consumption is prohibited anywhere on Town of West Windsor property except, under
 limited conditions, in the Multi-Use Recreation and Recreation Infrastructure Areas (up mountain and
 in sight of the AOC), in connection with events sponsored or co-sponsored by Ascutney Outdoors.
 In such cases, alcohol may be (1) served by an approved, duly licensed provider in accordance with
 local ordinances and State law, in a confined area with appropriate signage and oversight or (2)
 brought by event attendees for personal consumption under these BYOB regulations.

Not Permitted

- No liquor of any kind this includes mixers and hard alcohol.
- No shots, drinking games, or other activities that encourage inappropriate or excessive drinking.
- Absolutely no underage drinking.

Event Responsibility and Monitors

 Event sponsors and/or the licensed alcohol provider shall monitor and take responsibility for supervising that their participants abide by these BYOB regulations. Event sponsors should communicate these regulations to their participants.

Clean Up

 Users, event sponsors and their participants are responsible for cleanup and removal of all cans or bottles from the premises. Do not leave any unopened containers on premises.
